THE WORLD CUP COMPETITION THE NORDIC CUP COMPETITION 1 APRIL 2017 **INVITATION**

Dear casting sport and flycasting friends!

Estonian Casting Federation and Tallinna Kalasportide Klubi are happy to invite you to participate in Tallinn Indoor Cup 2017, the casting and flycasting tournament held on 1 April 2017 in Football Hall of EFA in Tallinn, Estonia. As the dimensions of the hall meet the highest FIFA requirements, it is possible to include ICSF single hand distance events and the flycasting distance events in the programme. Our aim is to bring casters from different styles and different countries together and tighten the sport friendship.





The venue: Football Hall of Estonian Football Association

Address: Asula 4b, Tallinn, Estonia

Court: 105*68 m, height 21m. Artificial grass.

The ICSF disciplines: #1 fly accuracy, #2 fly distance, #3 plug accuracy Arenberg, #4 plug accuracy, # 5 plug distance single hand, pentathlon, team competition in pentathlon(2 competitors per team). An extra duel competition with participation of 16 best casters will follow the official competitions. Due to safety reasons, it is prohibited to touch the ceiling with a plug in plug distance event. Relevant cast will be evaluated as "o".

The flycasting disciplines: Trout accuracy, trout distance, seatrout distance, salmon distance + all round in 4 events. For distance events, only flies, made from yarn/wool, are allowed.

Awards: 1st, 2nd and 3rd in single disciplines, multi events and team competitions in the following classes: juniors (boys and girls), adults (men and ladies) and veterans (60+for men and 55+ for ladies) in Tallinn Indoor Cup. A class would be ranked if at least 5 persons in a particular class declare their participation by 28 February. For World Cup, veteran men and men will be counted in the men class and the veteran ladies and ladies will be counted in the ladies class.

Schedule: The venue will be open for court building and practice on 31 March from 18:00 to 21:00. The warm-up and practice are available since 8:00 on 1 April. The estimated start of competitions is at 9:00 on 1st April. The exact schedule depends of the number of participants and will be specified by 5 March. The prize giving ceremony with banquet is estimated at 20:00 .

Transport: Transport to and from airport, harbour and hotel will be organized upon request by maxi taxis as always. For casters, travelling by Tallink, we have



special discount code with average discount of 35% for people and vehicles. To get that code, please contact with organizers.

Accommodation: We suggest Park Inn by Radisson Meriton Conference & Spa Hotel Tallinn <https://www.parkinn.co.ee/hotel-meriton-tallinn>. You can book directly by price of 55 € for standard single room or 65 € for standard twin/double room per night of 65€ and 75€ for superior rooms. Breakfast and free usage of saunas, spa and gym are included. Accommodation for prearranged referees will be covered by organizers.

Lunch: Served on the hall in thermal boxes with price of 8€ .Please let us know if there are some special requirements.

Registration: The deadline for indicative registration is 28 February 2015. Please specify the number of participants, disciplines and class. The final deadline is 15 March (see Annex I). Please register at allanlahi@gmail.com.

Cost: 45€ per participant for all casting events together or 10 € for single event; 10€ per event in flycasting events; 25€ for banquet. Bank transfers and usage of Transferwise with no losses in currency conversion are available.
